Additional eligibility criteria	<p>Applicants who have graduated and received a bachelor's degree from a domestic university or independent college accredited by the Ministry of Education, or from a foreign university or independent college recognized by the Ministry of Education; or those who fulfill relevant requirements of application for master's programs specified in the Standards for Recognition of Equivalent Educational Levels for University Admission.</p> <p>*Note: Applicants holding foreign degrees or equivalent academic qualifications must fulfill relevant requirements of the Standards for Recognition of Equivalent Educational Levels for University Admission; Regulations Governing the Assessment and Recognition of Foreign Academic Records by Institutions of Higher Education; Regulations Governing the Examination and Recognition of Educational Records from Hong Kong and Macao; or Regulations Governing the Assessment and Recognition of Educational Records from Mainland China.</p>		<p>Those who have served as professional technicians in universities/colleges or as professional and technical teachers in vocational schools or senior high schools; or those who have made outstanding achievements in their respective professional field.</p> <p>*Note 1: Applicants using the eligibility criteria in Article 6 or 7 of the Standards for Recognition of Equivalent Educational Levels for University Admission must undergo eligibility review by the NTNU Admissions Committee before being accepted for examination.</p> <p>*Note 2: Those who fulfill any of the criteria specified in Article 5 of the Standards for Recognition of Equivalent Educational Levels for University Admission may not apply using Article 6 or 7 of the same Standards, or their eligibility will be canceled.</p>

<p>Review of written documents</p>	<p>Applicants must log into the online application system during the application period to submit their applications, pay the application fee, and upload the following materials:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. One digital copy of the applicant’s original passport. b. A color photo in digital format of the applicant above the waist taken in the most recent year. c. One digital copy of the original copy of the applicant’s diploma from the highest degree obtained. If the original diploma is not printed in Chinese or English, an additional Chinese or English translation must be provided. d. One digital copy of the original copy of the applicant’s transcript for the most recent academic year. If the original transcript is not printed in Chinese or English, an additional Chinese or English translation must be provided. e. Applicant who is not with a diploma from Taiwan, please sign the “Deposition of Admission Documents” (see Attachment 2, please download) and upload the completed form to the registration system. f. Admission Prospectus Certificate of Employment (Attachment 3). g. Certificate of Employment from the Place of Work. h. One copy of the applicant’s study plan or research plan in Chinese (please refer to Appendix 4 and Appendix 5). i. One copy of the applicant’s autobiography in Chinese (approximately 800 words, please refer to Appendix 6). j. Two letters of recommendation written by teachers or supervisors at work. k. Proof of related work experience: Such as work experience in Mandarin teaching and overseas Chinese education. (Omit if inapplicable) l. Other information: Academic-industry collaborations, academic publications, or papers and thematic reports, etc. (Omit if inapplicable) m. Those who wish to apply for Division B (please see p. 10 for the eligibility criteria) must not only submit the required documents specified above for review, but also fill out the Application Form for Eligibility Review of Entrance Examination (Attachment 7) and submit it along with proofs related to personal professional achievements.

The secondary assessment will be conducted online (Please prepare the video conferencing software and conduct the online oral exam in accordance with the announced schedule). II. The list of applicants qualified for secondary assessment will be announced on the website of NTNU's Online Continuing Education Master’s Program of Teaching Chinese as a Foreign Language website on Friday, April 29, 2022 (Taiwan Time). III. Date of secondary assessment: To be announced separately.
<p>Other relevant rules</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> I. The maximum score of each exam item is 100 points. The maximum possible score is 100 points, which is the sum of the weighted percentage of each item. II. If the number of admissions to Division A does not fill its quota, the remaining quota may not be used to accept extra students into Division B. The remaining quota of Division B may be used to accept extra students into Division A. III. Accepted students must enroll for the academic year 2022-2023 and may not request deferral. IV.
